Introduction

[BeeGFS](#) is a parallel file system that we use on our cluster. The user home directories and the /scratch directory are stored there. A parallel file system allows you to access your files on all nodes simultaneously and transparently, as if it was local storage. If you access a different node (e.g. `srn -time=1:00:00 -pty /bin/bash`) you will still be able to access your home directory.
